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Guidance notes

What is the Sussex Student Card?

The card confirms that you are further education student aged 16 or over, living in the Sussex area (East Sussex, West Sussex and Brighton & Hove) and attending a school sixth form, sixth form college or a college of further education. N.B. Applications are not accepted from university students.

Each card has a unique number. If you wish to apply for a rail season ticket under the rail season ticket discount scheme (using www.southernrailway.com/further-ed/), you must include this number as part of your application. The card must be carried when using a rail season ticket purchased under the discount scheme.

How do I get a Sussex Student Card?

Complete the application form overleaf. A representative from your school/college must counter-sign the form to confirm that you are registered on a course. You will also need to include a recent passport style photograph with the application together with a self-addressed envelope to ensure that the card is returned to you as quickly as possible. Please check that all boxes have been completed to avoid any delay in issuing the card.
